Contemporary art work in the green areas of the Fabbrica del Vapore.

In its large square near the city centre, versatile and undergoing constant transformation, La Fabbrica hosts events linked to design, fashion, art and theatre, meetings and exchange. In a city of a decidedly industrial nature, such as Milan, the structure proves a skillful example of archeological recovery, bearing witness to the evolution of human manufacturing ability in the territory. Attention shifts to the green areas at the Fabbrica del Vapore and the way they interact with the structure as a whole, inviting visitors to discover unknown and mysterious corners of vegetation. Artists and creative minds from the project PARCHI NEL MONDO will take part in the project, interacting as harmoniously as possible with the green areas that exist there, enhancing and making the most of them. The areas that will be affected by the project are:

- the square in the middle of the Fabbrica, with Infrazione, curated by Marco Pirovano, Marco Fumagalli, with Fabio Dies. Branches pruned by the Milan City Council, boards for stages, videomapping.

the courtyards and gardens of Via Luigi Nono 7 with specific onsite initiatives. The keywords are interaction and exchange.
The artists will make sure their initiatives are appropriate by working onsite and not with installations conceived and made in a studio.
Various materials will be used, in line with the specific research the artists are involved in.

Sbobina Design's interior decoration arises out of the use of recycled industrial materials, mostly wood and iron: tables, chairs, armchairs, bookcases, stools, shelves, rocking chairs, benches occupy the space creatively instead of conventionally. Stefano Russo's installation follows the "fil rouge" of the relationship between past and present, presenting the complexity of human being, divided into systems, represented by objects from the past made of iron, copper, brass and glass, assembled and conserved in old suitcases, large and small.

In particular, the theme of design will devote close attention to the new "landscape" that embraces us with the Unicredit skyscraper. As well as the creative Labs, the Accademia, in collaboration with the young people of the Vapore Skate Team will create a "Raft of Madmen" with a fun lake full of toy boats and "fish" ready for fishing. For the fourth consecutive year the collaboration between INVIDEO by aiace and IED continues. The students have worked on the theme of digital sustainability; two interactive installations will be exhibited. The disciplines involved are Interaction/Media Design, Video Design and Sound Design by the School of Visual Communication, with lecturers Painè Cuadrelli, Davide Sgalippa and Paolo Solcia.

"Every day we entrust a large portion of our memory to digital supports, believing them to be containers that will last eternally. Invisible. "As it is not possible to identify precise cases of censorship in western countries where words arbitrarily removed by governments are not to be found, but where the origins of information are not given because they are covered by secrets, we have preferred to highlight only cases of evident censorship, as happens in some parts of the world."

In the installation by Gaetano Aliotta, Francesco Bonomi, Ding Shilei, Daniele Gavazza and Fabio Leone, the visitor observes a neutral world map and has available a series of words. He can chose a word and on the world map the areas where this word is subject to censorship will appear in colour accompanied by specific sounds linked to the word itself.

HORS PISTES by Marie Douel and Amandine David

HORS PISTES aims to bring together craftsmen and designers from all over the world through collective design workshops. Every two years organized workshops lead young designers in the discovery of foreign artefacts and at the same time support the craftsmen in the promotion of their know-how. The workshops are opportunities for research and experimentation in the two areas of design and craft production aiming to create innovative prototypes. At Posti di Vista 2014, for the first time Hors Pistes in collaboration with Careof DOCVA, brings to Milan the results of the experiment in Ouagadougou, capital of Burkina Faso, by French and Swiss designers and Burkinabe craftsmen who produced objects born from a mixture of their abilities and knowledge. These objects represent new identities constituted by hybrid visions and imagination in an exhibition that presents some of the objects created during the workshop. careof@careof.org

Laboratorio DAGAD Centre of documentation and research on architecture and industrial design

Awkward Design: anteprima

This research explores the concept of "awkwardness" linked to the social aspects and acceptance of certain objects.

The project will be developed over some years and will be devoted to the many specialities of industrial design that never make the headlines in events such as the Salone del Mobile (Furniture Fair) or feature in magazines.

In fact, because of the nature of the issues dealt with, they are purposely relegated to the sidelines. Death, weapons, sexuality, disability, imprisonment, medicine are the 6 sectors of production and study into which the research is organized.

To give a practical presentation of the idea, we have chosen once again this year to invite the IED Design, Rome, which often tackles these issues with its students and will be one of our partners in the project.

Coordinated by lecturer Marika Aakesson, work on robotics for children hospitalized in cancer wards, for communities for drug addicts and products for those obliged to live with diabetes will be presented.

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ILFISCHIO.doc Production and circulation of documentaries on culture and entertainment

LIFE STRIPE curated by Rossella Menegazzo, foresees the transposition of the main activities marking a day in the life of an individual onto 21 different-coloured stripes on a table divided into 24 hours. Alongside their exhibition work, the two artists have recently decided to run a workshop open to adults and children. The aim is to transform a day in a person's life into a little work of art made by cutting out strips of paper of different colours and with different textures according to the activities and the time devoted to them. The manual work and that of personal reflection leads to considerations on time, on the sense of everyday life and the values attributed to individual actions in our culture, identifying two tendencies: to create the future thinking of the past and to become self-aware through contact with others. The exhibition will be a meeting point thanks to the beautiful design of the works already created but also a place for workshops and encounters offered to the public during the days the exhibition is on. In the same context the video "Life Stripe in Motion" by Il Fischio.Doc on the students' work will also be screened.

The SPREAD workshop, open to everyone, will take place on Saturday 12 from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. On the 10th at 6 p.m. there will be a conversation with the curator, Rossella Menegazzo, on Japanese design, with a Japanese aperitif .

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MacchinazioniTeatrali Performing Arts and new technologies DESKTOP GARDENS

In the project The Secret Gardens, MacchinazioniTeatrali in collaboration with Laboratorio Alchemico, present their desktop gardens, sophisticated table gardens combining art and green design. Prof. Hal SOWA Ph.D will be bringing some examples of his own desktop garden creations from Japan and some of the Italian artists involved will create their personal version of these fascinating works for tables. MacchinazioniTeatrali will set the scene for the installation, placing the works in a suggestive light and sound setting.

NIO FAR 2014 will give a voice and space to co-development projects, cooperation and businesses that have achieved important objectives and are able to act as a model for positive collaboration between Italy and Senegal.

Amongst the results of initiatives already in progress, visitors to NIO FAR 2014 will see creations by a tailoring school and a furniture factory that have recently started to operate in Senegal. An opportunity to listen to and interact with associations, businesses and private people who will share their experiences at an important conference in line with the principles of NIO FAR and thus in the original spirit of "being together"; celebrating and sharing a cultural experience, a programme of percussion music, dance, cooking with traditional dishes and sewing sessions, aperitifs and refreshments from the Piroga Bar, theatre performances and concerts. On 12 April the competition Maratone Fotografiche will be launched, a photographic project involving the public and linking photography to urban mobility and the changing and evolving city.

HANDS ON DESIGN curated by SHIINA+NARDI DESIGN

Design meets craftwork. The design works and photographs exhibited are intended to offer the spectator tools for the evaluation of craft techniques, a highly topical issue in today's socio-economic context.

The return to handwork becomes a way of redeeming ourselves in the field of contemporary design, too. The design objects on exhibition, made of wood, pure wool felt, glass, wrought cast iron and lights made of different materials assume the value of products that are the fruit of careful thought and eminently usable. Reassuring and long-lasting objects with timeless value and the guarantee that comes from the materials and techniques used.

Polifemo wishes to make an important contribution to the definition of the concept behind the project. A series of professional and artistic images will fix some stages of work on the objects exhibited during their construction, highlighting the craft- and handwork that distinguishes them. The photographs will accompany the spectator as he views and "reads" the design objects presented, with the intention of bringing to light and exalting the value of craft and manual work, the producer and the artist.

OUT OF ORDER. Nonlinear Production Systems

Curated by Mikio Imai, Eugenia Morpurgo, Juan Montero, TRUO - Paolo Uboldi

The exploration of possible alternative processes to industrial production

The crisis of the system of industrial, mass-production has given rise to new, alternative, non-linear planning strategies influenced by factors and values that have up to now been quite foreign to the processes by which consumer products are made. New research for the designer, moved by the need to "recompose" the process of creation and production, and the new prospects offered to design by mass-customization, digital fabrication and Do-It-Yourself practices as they, no less importantly, reconsider the economic value of the product. The decentralization of mass production offers new inspiration and determines new relations between designer and consumer; no longer a one-way process of designer-production- consumption but planning that aims first and foremost to create a process of open and accessible production in which exchange, adaptability and flexibility can offer the opportunity to create an infinite range of personalized, modifiable and repairable products.

The new ways of elaborating design on exhibition focus on the production of personalized footwear, as in the case of designers Eugenia Morpurgo and Juan Montero, research on materials and surfaces by Mikio Imai and research on different modes of modelling for a series of products by Paolo Uboldi – studio TRUO.
