Sinossi/Synopsis

Time & Place (tr. it. *Tempo e luogo*) presenta un dialogo avvenuto tra l'autore e l'anziana madre. Senza mai inquadrarla, ma sempre ascoltandone la voce o scrutando alcuni particolari del suo corpo, la donna ripercorre cinquanta anni di vita vissuta in una casa affacciata su un canale di Amsterdam.

Time & Place presents a dialogue which took place between the author and his elderly mother. Without ever appearing in the frame, but with her voice being heard or details of her body being scrutinized, the woman goes back over fifty years of life in a house looking on to a canal in Amsterdam.
